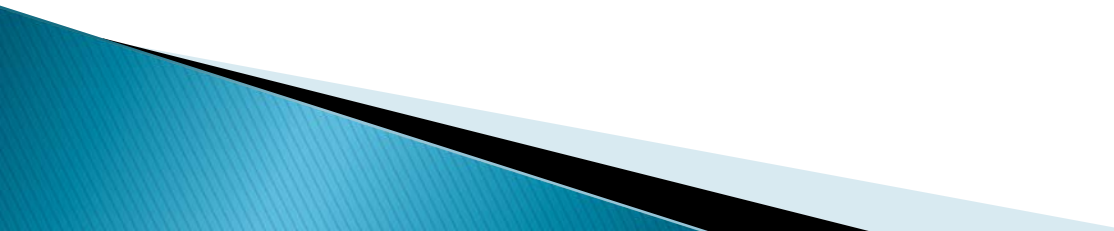


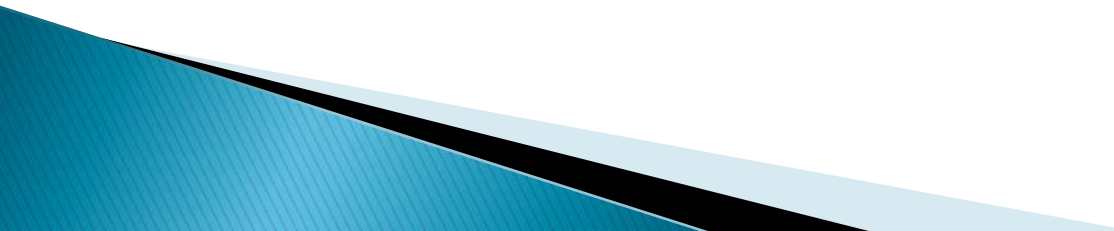
# Small-talk with ALDE

10 minutes in a fraction meeting

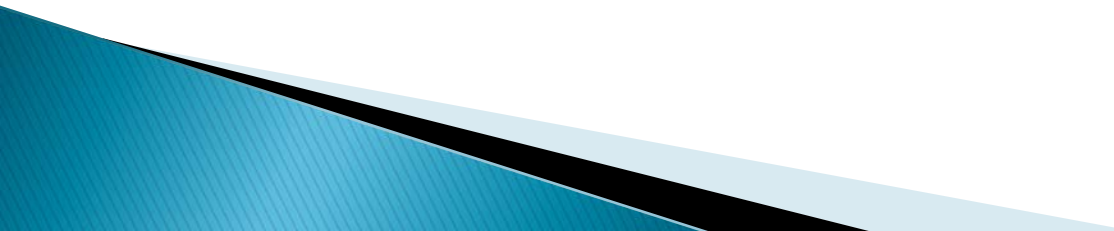
# 1. What was your first impression of MEP?

  - ▶ Nikita M.: I was not really nervous because it is already the third time I participate at MEP. It is all very interesting.
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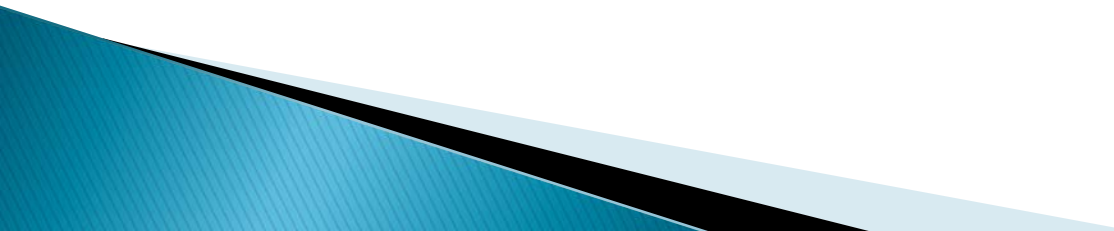
## 2. Is it the first time you are participating at MEP?

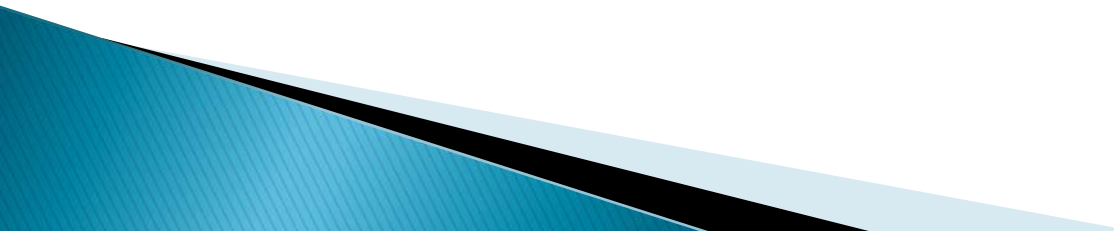
### 3. Are your expectations you had before fulfilled?
