SECTION 1: PURPOSE

1.1 The Overseas Teachers' Association regroups Canadian teachers from across Canada who are on a loan of Service Agreement with the DND Dependants Schools Overseas.

SECTION 3: EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

3.1 The Executive Committee consists of the president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer. Either the president or vice-president is the representative from SHAPE. Members from AFNORTH hold all remaining executive positions.

SECTION 4: AIMS

4.1 The aims of the Overseas Teachers' Association are:

- (a) To promote and safeguard the interests of the teachers and to afford them: assistance in their duties and relationships.
- (b) To act in cooperation with the Canadian Forces, DDEM and the Canadian Teachers' Federation.
- (c) To promote and safeguard the emotional, social and academic development of the students enrolled in the DND Dependants Schools Overseas.
- (d) To foster community relations and intercultural activities.
- (e) To coordinate and support educational activities within the educational, military and European communities.
- (f) To facilitate the orientation and repatriation of the membership.
- (g) To disseminate information from the Canadian Teachers' Federation to the membership.
- (h) Promote the OTA developed code of ethics found at *OSAP 200.19.2 Annex A*.

SECTION 5: MATTERS RELATING TO THE TRIPARTITE LOAN OF SERVICE AGREEMENT

5.1 All matters relating to the Tripartite Loan of Service Agreement and to the Offices of the DDEM and the Minister of National Defence shall be dealt with through the Canadian Teachers' Federation (CTF). CTF shall serve as a liaison and a clearinghouse between OTA and the provincial/territorial teachers' organization to which its members are affiliated.
